Method

Quantitative online survey

Samples:

- Online research was conducted on behalf of Essity by OnePoll between 20th to 31st January 2023
- 2. 500 women (18+) who have not yet started the menopause were interviewed
- 3. Data splits were provided based on:
 - Age
 - Region



Summary

- Two fifths (40%) **know what the perimenopause** is. Of those who know what perimenopause is, on average they believe there to be **23.33** symptoms with the most expected symptom being vaginal dryness (32%).
- On average, respondents expect there to be **20.89 symptoms of menopause**, with the most expected symptom being **mood swings** (28%). 18% were surprised to learn that urinary infections are a symptom of menopause.
- The average expected age of menopause was 46.02 years old.
- 10% feel there is **not enough awareness of menopause** in the general public, while 43% think that there is some awareness but more needs to be done.
- 65% think that the age you start menopause can be hereditary, while 62% think there can be a correlation between the age you start your period and the onset of menopause.
- 62% agree that going through the menopause means you are officially old. With 41% thinking that you can't get pregnant when going through the menopause, and 48% believe menopause begins when a woman stops having her period.
- 51% of respondents believe all women go through menopause, and on average think menopause lasts for 5.36 years.

Perimenopause

- Two fifths (40%) know what the **perimenopause** is
- While 43% have heard the term but don't know what it is

Of those who know what the perimenopause is (n=200):

- 58% believe symptoms are caused by the changing levels of hormones in the body
 - 55% say that during the perimenopause the **menstrual** cycle lengthens and flow may become irregular
 - And 51% think it is the natural process caused when your ovaries gradually stop working
- On average, respondents believe there to be 23.33 symptoms of perimenopause
- Almost a third (32%) say vaginal dryness is a symptom of perimenopause
- This was followed by:

- Headaches (30%)
- Mood swings (30%)
- Hot flushes (29%)

Question:

To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statement: "I am 100% confident I know everything there is to know about the menopause"



Insight

- 67% agree they are 100% confident they know everything there is to know about the menopause
 - A quarter (25%) strongly agree this is the case
- While 18% **disagree** they are confident about this



Signs of menopause

- On average, respondents believe there to be 20.89 symptoms of menopause
- 28% think **mood swings** are a side effect or symptom of menopause
- This was followed by:
 - Irritability (28%)
 - Hot flushes (27%)
 - Vaginal dryness (27%)

Of those who did not select all listed symptoms in the previous question (n=495):

- Nearly a fifth (18%) were **most surprised** that **urinary infections** were a side effect or symptom of menopause
 - 17% were surprised by breathlessness
 - With another 17% selecting 'tinnitus'
 - And 16% were surprised that they might experience night sweats in menopause

Question:

At what age, do you believe, women are most likely to start experiencing symptoms of the menopause?

• On average, respondents believe women most likely start experiencing symptoms of menopause at age 46.02

Menopause awareness

- 31% think there is a **lot of awareness** surrounding the menopause among the general public
- With 43% saying there is some awareness, but **more could still be done**
- And 10% feel there is **not enough awareness**
- 65% believe the age you start the menopause is **hereditary**
 - With 28% thinking this is the case for all women
- 12% do not think it is hereditary at all
- 62% believe that if you start your periods early this can mean you will start the menopause early
 - With 27% thinking this is the case for all women
- 16% do not think there is any correlation here
- 34% think that women still produce oestrogen after the menopause
- While 35% think they do not



Question:

Which of the following statements, if any, do you believe to be true?



Insight

- 44% believe that menopause changes your personality
 - With 42% thinking that perimenopause changes your personality
 - And 40% think that **menopause** makes you angry



Menopause myths

- Nearly half (48%) believe **menopause begins** when a woman **stops having her period**
- This was followed by:
 - Menopause marks the end of a woman's mothering instinct (42%)
 - Menopause leads to a decrease in sex drive (42%)
 - You can't get pregnant when going through the menopause (41%)
- Thinking of 'old wives tales' they would try to help ease the symptoms / side effects of menopause, 49% would drink lots of water to reduce dryness caused by menopause
 - 46% would cut out sugars and processed foods to make them feel less tired and irritable
 - And 45% would avoid caffeine, alcohol, and foods that are sugary or spicy to reduce excess sweating
- 62% agree that going through the menopause means you are officially old
- 22% **disagree** this is the case

Surgical menopause

- 51% believe all women go through the menopause
- On average, respondents believe menopause lasts for 5.36 years
 - 48% think menopause lasts for 5 or more years
- 27% say they know what surgical menopause is
- While 44% do not

Of those who know what the surgical menopause is (n=137):

- 66% think it can cause women to experience more severe symptoms than if they were to experience menopause naturally
 - 58% think that the menopause is **triggered in women** regardless of their age following the procedure
 - 47% believe that causes an **abrupt menopause**
 - And another 47% believe it stops a woman's menstrual periods
